Die Boodskap vertaling lyk anders, maar dit dra dieselfde boodskap oor "In die begin van alle tyd het God die hemel en die aarde gemaak."

Ek het 'n swart band 1983 vertaling, ek het 'n klein bruin leer 1933/53 vertaling, ek het 'n klein donker-bruin (amper maroen) Nuwe Lewende Vertaling, ek het 'n blou Boodskap vertaling en ek het onlangs by my legitimasie 'n splinter nuwe 2020 vertaling gekry, as geskenk van die sinode af, omdat ek my studies klaar gemaak het. Ek het notas in elkeen gemaak van kleins af. Eers net merkies onder die vers nommers om vir my te wys dat hierdie vers mooi is. Ek noem dit want as ek so na die begin van al my Bybels kyk, dan is die manier hoe dit begin altyd vir my so mooi.

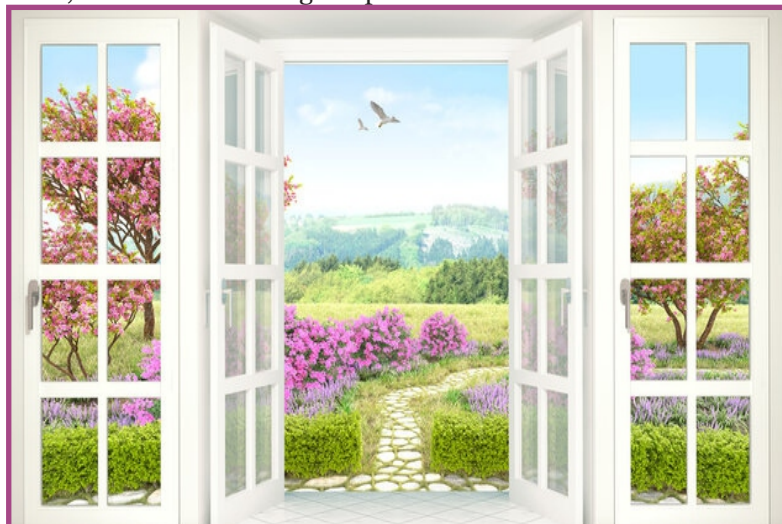
Elke vertaling (ja daar is 'n paar verskille) begin met hierdie mooi woorde wat vir ons kom wys dat ons God in die begin geskep het. Hoe mooi is daardie geloofsbelydenis nie. Ons God het hemel en aarde geskep. Alles wat ons om ons sien, ons God het dit geskep.

Die plante, die diere, die riviere, die mense, die son, die sterre en nog vele meer. Wanneer ons dan weer na Genesis 1 kyk, dan hoop ek ons kyk bietjie vas in hierdie belydenis. Ons God het geskep. 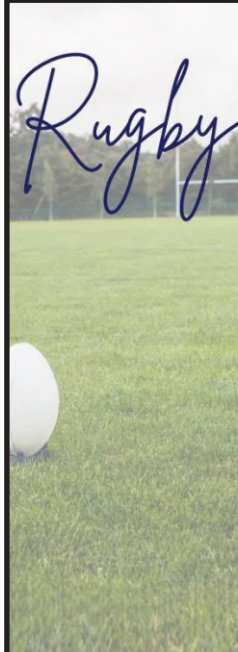

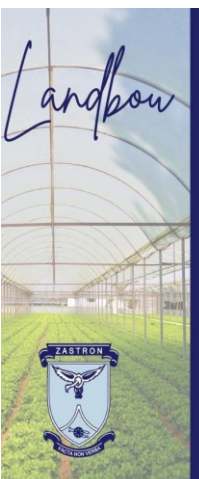
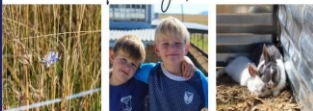

STOCKTHEFT OPERATION YIELDS POSITIVE RESULTS

ORTambo, 19 MAY 2025. A joint, pre planned anti-stocktheft operation, by three neighbouring districts, being Alfred Nzo, Joe Gqabi and OR Tambo, to curb stock theft, which started on 13 May 2025 and ended on 17 May 2025, resulted in the impoundment of suspected stolen livestock, with the rightful owners awaiting to identify and claim them. The operation focused on iden-tified areas of *Qumbu, Sulenkama, Tsolo kwaBhaca, Maclear, Tloekeng (Matatiele) and Ngqayi (Katkop)*, to name a few with the most stocktheft victims on board. Amongst the unclaimed, impounded stock, there were 231 mixed cattle, estimated at a value of R2 772 000,00. 81 mixed sheep valued at around R162 000,00. 78 goats, valued at around R156 000,00. Impounded cattle are kept at Qumbu Municipality Stock Pound,

whilst the goats and sheep are at Tsolo Municipality Stock Pound. During the operation, police arrested a 27 year old male suspect, of Mahlun-gulu locality, Qumbu, on the N2 road, at the Sulenkama junction, driving a suspected to be stolen Toyota Avanza, with a Soweto Cas number of April 2025. Traffic fines to the value of R9500,00 were issued, with offences ranging from driving without a driver's licenses, to driving a unroadworthy vehicle, whilst in Lusikisiki compliance inspections were conducted in three butch-eries. Police are urging anyone whose stock has been stolen to visit Qumbu Municipality Stock Pound, for cattle and Tsolo Municipality Stock Pound, for sheep and goats, via the Stock Theft and Endangered Species Unit offices, to identify their lost or stolen stock, with all the necessary

stock documentation. The joint operation by the three districts conducted by committed men and women in blue is highly commended by the District Commissioners of the three affected districts, voicing out their eagerness and commitment in fighting stock theft in their respective districts.

BURGERSDORP SAPS CRACK DOWN ON DRUG DEALERS

Burgersdorp, 20 May 2025.

SAPS members continued efforts help to prevent and detect the dealing in drugs, yield positive results in Burgersdorp.

The SAPS team, that included the Station Commander, Detective Commaner and members from crime prevention, cracked down on drug dealers, in Burgersdorp, in the Mzamomhle locality, on 19 May 2025, in three unrelated cases. The first suspect, 39 years old, was arrested after members monitored an identified house, where a suspect bought dagga. Thirteen, ready made zols and 13 button bags of dagga, as well as some cash, was confiscated. Members attentiveness and quick response, also led to the arrest of a 25 year old suspect, that was also selling dagga from his home, through the window. When the SAPS searched the house, the drugs were found in butter containers in the stove. 49 Button bags of dagga, in different sizes, as well as some

cash was confiscated. During the third incident, the SAPS followed up on positive information, where the suspect sold dagga from a bucket that he sits on. The SAPS found the dagga under the bucket, as well as dagga in his home. The 25 year old suspect was arrested and 20 parcellen of dagga, 10 button bags of dagga, 10 parcels of dagga, 2 plastic bags containing loose dagga, 8 tik smoking pipes and cash was confiscated. All the suspects will appear in the Burgersdorp Magistrate Court on the charges of dealing in dagga. The Joe Gqabi District Commissioner, Major General Lindelwa Vellem commended the members on the successful arrests and confiscations. SUSPECT ARRESTED WITH DRUGS AT NQANQARHU (MACLEAR) TAXI RANK

Nqanqarhu, 21 May 2025: SAPS specialised units often assist stations across the District Borders with their crime prevention endeavors in the prevention and detection of drug dealing.

On 20 May 2025, at 06:00, members of the Khowa (Elliot) K9 Unit and the Barkly East Mounted Unit followed up on positive information during an intelligence driven operation at Nqanqarhu (Maclear) taxi rank.

The 34 year old identified suspect was stopped and searched and was found in possession of 24 small zip plastic bags containing tik, he was then arrested.

He will appear in the Nqanqarhu Magistrate Court. The Joe Gqabi District Commissioner, Major General Lindelwa Vellem, commended the members of the team, that made the successful arrest and confiscations possible. Drug dealers often target small towns and rural areas as they think they can operate undetected, but due to the SAPS and the communities good working relation and the fact that these activities will not be tolerated in our communities, the drug dealers are being identified and arrested.

Aliwal Toyota

Over 45 Years of Family, Growth and Community.

In August 1979, Allan Venter, opened the doors to a modest Toyota dealership, at 74 Somerset Street in Aliwal North. With just five staff members, a compact showroom and a strong commitment to customer service, the business began selling approximately four vehicles a month.

Their first sale, a Cressida Station Wagon for R6 822.00, was made to Mr. Ed Hughes from Burgersdorp, marking the start of an incredible forty five year journey.

Initially focused on vehicle sales, the workshop was sublet to Mr. Koos Bekker. However, as the dealership grew, so did its capacity and services. In March 1988, Gustaf van Aardt joined the team as a salesman and has since played a vital role in the company's success, eventually becoming Sales Manager and Director.

In 1994, Allan's son, Jacques Venter, brought a decade of banking experience to the business and was appointed Dealer

Principal in 1999.

By 1998, Aliwal Toyota took full control of its workshop operations, servicing six vehicles a day with a small technical team.

In 2002, the property was purchased from Total SA, allowing for a much-needed cosmetic upgrade. As demand grew, a second showroom was opened in 2007, in Grey Street, to accommodate pre-owned Automark vehicles.

Despite the pressures of the global financial crisis, Jacques and Gustaf made the bold decision to invest in a major upgrade aligned with Toyota South Africa's New Retail Concept.

Between 2007 and 2008, a complete knock down and rebuild, transformed the Somerset Street site into a modern dealership, with a showroom triple the size of the original, a large parts store and a fully equipped workshop capable of servicing over 20 vehicles a day. The new facility officially opened on 26 November 2008.

The investment proved worthwhile. Since then, Aliwal Toyota has grown exponentially.

In 2019, Jacques' son, Warren Venter, joined the business, becoming the third generation of the Venter family to carry the legacy forward.

Despite facing significant challenges in recent years, including the COVID-19 pandemic, civil unrest and flooding at Toyota's Durban plant and a tough economic climate, Aliwal Toyota has continued to adapt, grow, and thrive.

The dealership is currently developing a new showroom and workshop on Somerset Street, which will consolidate the Automark division and house a new vehicle fitment centre. From its humble beginnings, the team has grown from five, to over 50 employees.

Vehicle sales have expanded from 48 per year, to more than 200 sales annually.

The workshop now services up to 25 vehicles daily and the business supports a service area extending over 200 km into the North-Eastern Cape and Southern Free State.

Aliwal Toyota remains one of the few independent, family-owned dealerships in South Africa. This success would not have been possible without the continued support of our community. We extend our sincere gratitude to our loyal customers, past and present. While we sell and service vehicles, it is people who remain at the heart of our business.
